

supported for a number of years- because Presbyterians support public education! It is DonorsChoose, a website where teachers post requests for classroom re-



REGIPE OF THE MONTH

Summer Corn Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 6 ears corn, husked and cleaned
- 3 large tomatoes, diced
- 1 large onion, diced
- ¼ cup chopped fresh basil
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons white vinegar
- Salt and pepper to taste



PREPARATION

- 1. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook corn in boiling water for 7 to 10 minutes, or until desired tenderness. Drain, cool, and cut kernels off the cob with a sharp knife.
- 2. Toss corn, tomatoes, onion, basil, oil, vinegar, salt, and pepper in a large bowl; chill until serving.
